




Initial Concepts

The final concept prototype of the product. It is at half scale and is created from a 3D printer and modeling clay. It was painted to be as close to the the color of the actual fruit colors and shaped to be as close to the actual fruit shapes. There is some add texture to the peach to give it a fuzzy feel as a real peach is, and the strawberry has the seeds to give it a slightly bumpy feel. They are connected by magnets.
