The Jason Schneider Memorial

The Baltimore County Police Department looked for ways to help Jason's family. Members of the department's Firearms Training team opted for a golf tournament in memory of Jason. The standard flags would be replaced with Thin Blue Line flags that would have an officer's name who was killed in the line of duty and their end of watch number.

The inaugural golf tournament was held on May 5th, 2014 at Hayfields Country Club in Hunt Valley, MD.
